on Thursday, September 30, 1948

This day will be known as K. T. KELLER DAY. A meeting will be held at the Mount Joy High School at 3:30 P.M., when Governor James H. Duff will confer the honor upon Mr. Keller, making him a Pennsylvania Ambassador. This day will be a holiday in Mount Joy. All stores will be closed and all industries in Mount Joy will be shut down on Thursday afternoon, September, 30, 1948.

EVERYBODY INVITED TO BE PRESENT.

Mr. Keller will arrive at Mount Joy's P.R.R. Passenger Station at 11:10 A.M., September 30, 1948, where hundreds of school children and other citizens of Mount Joy will greet him. After a brief reception he will be escorted by the Entertainment Committee to the Brunswick Hotel, Lancaster, where he will be entertained by Lancaster's Chamber of Commerce and the Service Clubs at a luncheon.

The Committee will escort Mr. Keller back to Mount Joy where the chief assembly of the day will begin at 3:30 P.M., and where he will be dubbed "Pennsylvania's Ambassador" by Governor James H. Duff, who has designated him as worthy of this honor.

This meeting will be held at the Mount Joy High School located at the end of Poplar Street and one and one-half blocks southward from Marietta Street. The meeting will be held on the Athletic Field just south of the High School Building. In case of unfavorable weather, the meeting will be held in the High School Auditorium. Loud speakers will be installed all over the place so that everybody can hear the proceedings.

Since we gave the news item to the local paper a change is being made in the program because of the fact that we have been able to get the Pottstown Band and Glee Club to be present during the public meeting and thereafter until Mr. Keller's departure. This Band and Glee Club will take part in the main exercises which begin at 3:30 P.M. and after the meeting this same Band and Glee Club will continue to entertain the people until the end of the day's festivities. The outdoor movies which we previously announced will not occur because we believe the entertainment of the Band and Glee Club will be much more pleasing to everybody. This Band will be with us until Mr. Keller's departure at 7:57 P.M. There are 36 pieces in the Band and 48 voices in the Glee Club.

We want to keep all the people together until Mr. Keller departs on the "Red Arrow" at 7:57 P.M. so that he may have full opportunity to see and meet old and new friends. The Committee expects an attendance of not less than 3 000 people.
