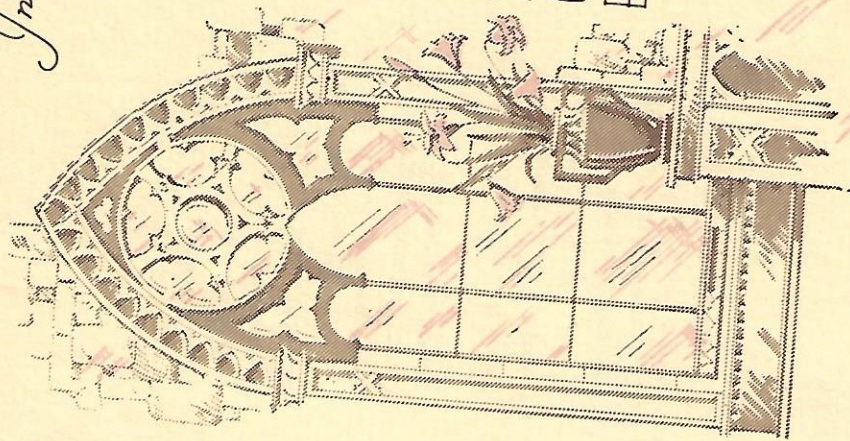

C. A. Hendrix, Mt. Joy, Expires

Clayton A. Hendrix, seventy-nine, retired Mount Joy painter and paperhanger, died in the Columbia Hospital at 3:45 a. m. Sunday.

A lifetime resident of Mount Joy, Hendrix moved to Marietta when he became ill about a year ago. He lived last with his daughter Esther, wife of H. J. Smith, 392 E. Front St., Marietta.



Hendrix was born in a portion of Rapho Twp. that was later annexed by Mount Joy. He was a son of the late John and Anna Thatcher Hendrix.

He and his wife, Emma Zink Hendrix, celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary in May.

Hendrix was a member of St. Mark's Evangelical United Brethren Church, the Friendship Fire Co. and the Fraternal Order of Eagles, all at Mount Joy, and the Columbia Fraternal and Beneficial Assn.
