Churches and Clubs

Mount Joy may be a growing community, but it still retains its small town charm. Mount Joy's sense of Community comes from its residents' involvement and civic engagement.

Over two dozen churches and places of worship are located in the Mount Joy area. There are also a large variety of civic organizations, clubs, and groups.

Education

The area has a great public school system, as well as a public library that offers a variety of services to local and county residents.

The Donegal School District opened the new high school in 2012 and is currently renovating the intermediate school and the junior high school.

Also in Mount Joy is the Lancaster County Career and Technology Center and the Janus School.

The award-winning Milanof-Schock public library offers a great deal of services that reflect the informational, educational, and recreational needs of area residents. Most of the services offered by the library are free of charge for any Lancaster County resident with a library card.

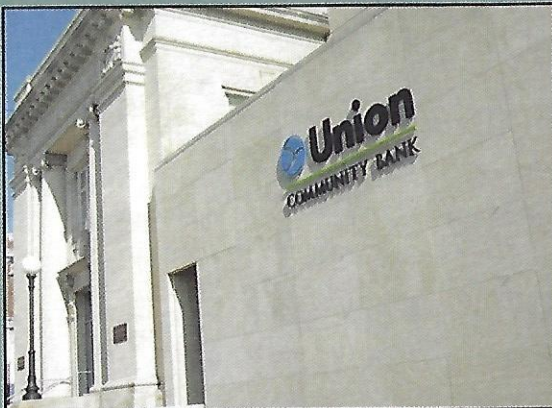
WORK and Play

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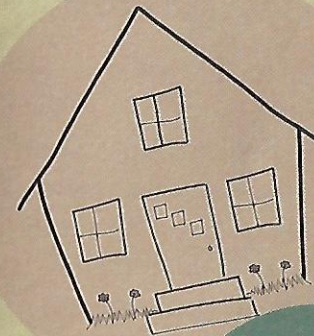
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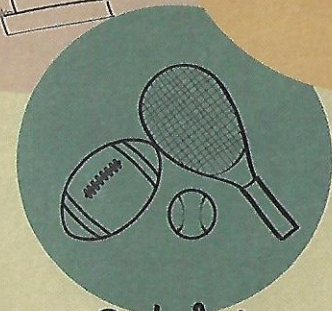
