Dear Members:

We are enclosing your application for the 2011 swimming season. When completing your application this year, remember, only those members of your household that you claim on your Federal Tax return are eligible for membership. List only those members of your household who are eligible for season passes. Others living in the household are not eligible for membership but can come to the pool as your paying guest. Please make your check payable to the Mount Joy Lions' Swimming Pool and send the card and check in the enclosed envelope. Since we are now using photo ID's, you can report to the pool on the two Saturdays preceding the opening of the pool for your photo and ID pick-up. (May 14 & 21 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm) Photo IDs will also be issued Memorial Day weekend. Children not in school will not be photographed.

A Message to Pool Members from the Operating Authority

The Pool Operating Authority has appointed Alison Kreider of Elizabethtown as our Pool Manager for the 2011 summer season. Alison comes to the Mount Joy Lions Club Swimming Pool with significant experience in aquatics and pool management, and the Authority is looking forward to a very active summer.

The Pool Operating Authority is holding 2011 seasonal rates at 2010 rates. To do so, the Authority has carefully developed a 2011 budget that reflects a reduction in capital improvements for this year and will be closely monitoring operating expenses over the course of the 2011 summer season. We have invested over \$55,000.00 in capital improvements over the past two years and are going to use the 2011 summer season to rebuild our capital reserve. Additionally, we are, in part, able to avoid an increase in season rates by adding to our season cash flow by opening the pool to the community on our Tuesday and Thursday Community Days. The Authority expects to review the Community Days arrangement through the spring to determine any possible changes.

The Pool Operating Authority continues to review and discuss the use of our pool by local day-care groups. We believe that the use of our facility by day-care groups is consistent with the vision of the Mount Joy Lions Club that supports service to the community. The Authority will continue to work with the day-care groups that use our facility to better balance the needs of our members and to better avoid conflicts throughout the 2011 season.

Members are reminded to notify the membership chairman of any change in address or additions to your family. Additionally, to ease the rush for photo-IDs on opening weekend, members are encouraged to come to the pool on either Saturday, May 14th, or Saturday May 21st, between 10:00am and 2:00pm for your photo-IDs. Photo-IDs will be available beginning with our season opening on Saturday, May 28th during regular operating hours. The pool opens for the 2011 season on May 28th after the completion of the Memorial Day Parade, which will be approximately 3:00 pm. All hours are subject to appropriate weather conditions.

We are looking forward to an outstanding 2011 season. We encourage you to share thoughts and questions with the Pool Manager and members of the Operating Authority. 




Who:
