TRAVELOGUES

COPPER CANYON MEXICO

The primitive Tarahumara Indians live in the Copper Canyon. The Mexican government can only estimate the number of Indians living in the vast expanses of the canyon. The photogenic Copper Canyon is larger than Arizona's Grand Canyon. A trip through the canyon can be done only by train. The tracks were completed in the late 60's. Tourism began in the 70's.

CUBA

Visit Hershey, Cuba and other facets of life on this beautiful island where only those with special permission may travel.

SCOTLAND

This travelogue features the western highlands and the islands of Lewis, Harris and Skye. An iron-age home and Callanish (which dates back to 3000 B.C.) are featured.

ISRAEL AND JORDAN

This travelogue features Petra, the lost city carved our of rose-colored rock in Jordan, plus

Biblical places in Israel.

GALAPAGOS ISLANDS ECUADOR

This travelogue features a very special area where wild life, plants, and even the earth are protected. Only 50,000 people per year are allowed to visit the islands.

MARVELS OF PERU

This travelogue features the beautiful Indians of Peru, Inca legacy, the dream-like Machu Picchu and natives living on reed islands
