Dr. Ralph W. Schlosser

Born in Schoeneck, Lancaster County, Dr. Ralph W. Schlosser, lecturer and preacher, graduated from Ephrata High School in 1904. He received a bachelor of arts degree from Ursinus College, a master of arts degree from Columbia University, and a doctor of letters degree from Ursinus. Dr. Schlosser also attended Bethany Theological Seminary, Chicago, and Union Theological Seminary, New York City.

After teaching for two years in rural schools in Lancaster County, he served as a professor at both Juniata College and Elizabethtown College, as dean of the latter from 1922-27, and as president of Elizabethtown College from 1927-1941. In 1962 he became president emeritus at the college, where he is still teaching.

An ordained minister of the Church of the Brethren, Dr. Schlosser was moderator of the church in 1952 and is a member of its Board of Administration and chairman of its Commission on Evangelism. He is also a past district governor of Rotary International.

Dr. Schlosser is married to the former Elizabeth Souder and has four children, one of whom, Dr. David E. Schlosser, resides in Mount Joy.
